

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE
MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE TOWN OF VIDALIA, LOUISIANA,
HELD ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2017 AT NOON
IN THE TOWN HALL MEETING ROOM**

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Vidalia, Louisiana, met, in special session, in the Town Hall Meeting Room in Vidalia, Louisiana, on Monday, November 20, 2017, at NOON.

There were present: Mayor Pro Tempore Tommy Probst, Aldermen Jon Betts and Tron McCoy and Alderwoman Sabrina Dore’.

There were absent: Mayor Buz Craft and Alderman Robert Gardner.

There were also present: Assistant City Clerk, Jay LaSyone and Executive Assistant to the Mayor, Pam Middleton; and James Thomas, a representative of Riverside Baptist Church.

The meeting was opened by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance, and the invocation was given by Mayor Pro Tempore Probst.

A quorum being present, the Mayor Pro Tempore declared the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Vidalia, Louisiana, to be duly convened, in special session, as the governing authority of said municipality and opened the meeting for the conduct of business.

The first and only item on the agenda was the introduction of an Ordinance to sell city-owned surplus property located adjacent to Riverside Baptist Church.

Prior to introducing the Ordinance, Mayor Pro Tempore Probst advised the Board that the Board would need to select a date, after December 13, in which to have the special meeting and the public hearing in order to adopt the Ordinance before the regular January meeting. After some discussion, the Board decided to hold a public hearing and special meeting at 9:00 o’clock A.M. on Friday, December 15, 2017. That information was filled in on the typed Ordinance and the Ordinance was introduced (pre-filed) by Alderman McCoy.

The City Attorney then advised that the Notice of Public Hearing and the Notice of Intent has been prepared and will be published three (3) times, in the issues of November 29, December 6, and December 13, 2017, in The Concordia Sentinel.

There being no further business, on motion of Alderwoman Dore’, seconded by Alderman McCoy, and unanimously carried, the special meeting was adjourned.
