

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE  
MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE TOWN OF VIDALIA, LOUISIANA,  
HELD ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2017 AT 9:00 A.M.  
IN THE TOWN HALL MEETING ROOM**

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Vidalia, Louisiana, met, in special session, in the Town Hall Meeting Room in Vidalia, Louisiana, on Friday, December 15, 2017, at 9:00 A.M.

There were present: Mayor Buz Craft, Aldermen Tommy Probst, Jon Betts, and Alderwoman Sabrina Dore'.

There were absent: Aldermen Robert Gardner and Tron McCoy.

There were also present: Assistant City Clerk, Jay LaSyone and Executive Assistant to the Mayor, Pam Middleton; and James Thomas, representing Riverside Baptist Church.

The meeting was opened by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance, and the invocation was given by Mayor Buz Craft.

A quorum being present, the Mayor declared the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Vidalia, Louisiana, to be duly convened, in special session, as the governing authority of said municipality and opened the meeting for the conduct of business.

The first and only item on the agenda was the adoption of an Ordinance to sell immovable property located adjacent to Riverside Baptist Church.

Alderwoman Dore' moved to open the public hearing, seconded by Alderman Probst and unanimously carried by those present. The public hearing being opened, the Mayor announced that there had been no written objection filed prior to the deadline as fixed by State law, and no one appeared to object, and the public meeting was closed. Prior to voting on the adoption, the Mayor read aloud the title of the ordinance. Thereafter, after a brief discussion, a motion was made by Alderwoman Dore' to adopt the ordinance as introduced, seconded by Alderman Probst. The vote thereon was as follows;

YAYS: Alderman Betts, Alderwoman Dore', and Alderman Probst.

NAYS: NONE.

ABSENT: Aldermen Gardner and McCoy.

ABSTAINING: NONE.

WHEREUPON, the Mayor declared the Ordinance to be duly adopted.
